Regina Rowing Club – Head Coach

Duties:

- Promote the Regina Rowing Club and its various programmes
- Contribute to an atmosphere where the Club and its athletes can excel.
- Attend all coaching and board meetings. Maintain working relationships with the board, members at large, and volunteers.
- Ensure equipment and boathouse policies are adhered to by RRC members.
- Make recommendations with respect to acquisition and maintenance of equipment,
- Ensure broken equipment is brought to the attention of the equipment manager. Assist with the maintenance and repair of club equipment.
- Develop a comprehensive equipment plan for boat & oar allocation, rigging and maintenance.
- Ensure the safety of participants
- Develop periodized annual training program.
- Ensure that Club policy is understood and carried out by Club Coaches and competitive members, particularly safety and equipment policies.
- Prepare competitive athletes to achieve excellence at their respective championships, particularly the NorthWest Rowing Association Championships, Royal Canadian Henley Regatta, and the Canadian Secondary School Rowing Association regatta.
- The Head Coach will also be responsible for preparing the top club athletes for provincial and national team selections, provincial and national championships and trials.
- Keep record of hours worked and tasks performed. Submit weekly.
