

# 2018 Saskatchewan Rowing Association High Performance Selection Document

#### Purpose

The Saskatchewan Rowing Association (SRA) will select and support athletes who qualify to attend the following 2018 events:

- Canadian Secondary Schools Rowing Association (CSSRA) Championships
  - o June 1-3, St. Catharines, ON
- Rowing Canada Aviron (RCA) Speed Orders
  - o June 22-24, London, ON
- RCA U23 World Championship Selection Camp and Time Trial
  - o June 25-28, London, ON
- RCA Junior Team Stage 2 and Stage 3 Selection
  - o June 4-5, Welland, ON (Stage 2)
  - o June 26-30, ON (venue TBC; Stage 3)
- National Rowing Championships/Canada Cup
  - o November 8-11, Burnaby, BC

#### <u>Vision</u>

Provide national team hopefuls suitable opportunities for their athletic development.

#### <u>About</u>

RCA Speed Orders and the National Rowing Championships (NRCs) have races in singles (1x), and pairs (2-) only.

#### <u>Requirements</u>

Athletes are nominated by the SRA High Performance Committee based on the following criteria:

- Eligibility as required of the event
- Attendance at training
- Commitment, coachability, and attitude
- Developmentally-appropriate
- Competitiveness

Event entries are at the discretion of the Provincial Coaches, based on the criteria listed above.

#### **Eligibility**

Athletes must meet the eligibility requirements of the host event.

## **Concept 2 Rowing Ergometer Standards**

All 2000m erg tests must be witnessed by a recognized coach.

- Men
  - o Open: Sub 6:10.0
  - o Lightweight: Sub 6:20.0
  - o U23 Open: Sub 6:15.0
  - o U23 Lightweight: Sub 6:40.0
  - o U19: Sub 6:40.0
- Women
  - o Open: Sub 7:10.0
  - o Lightweight: Sub 7:20.0
  - o U23 Open: Sub 7:15.0
  - o U23 Lightweight: Sub 7:40.0
  - o U19: Sub 7:40.0

#### **On Water Selection**

Athletes selected to compete at the 2018 Speed Orders must have demonstrated in the past year that their on-water performance deems them competitive for U23/Senior World Championship selection.

National Rowing Championships/Canada Cup: SRA Provincial Coaches will assess each interested athlete's on-water performance through the past racing season to determine if the NRCs are a suitable regatta for the athlete to attend at this juncture of their development. Some athletes may be pre-selected due to previous summer on water results if s/he is attending school out of province.

#### <u>Assessment Fee</u>

Upon being named to any of the following teams, athletes are responsible to pay the Saskatchewan Rowing Association an assessment fee to subsidize costs.

## Code of Conduct

All athletes selected to Saskatchewan Rowing teams are responsible to sign and abide by the SRA Code of Conduct. This document will be available at a future date.
