The Regina Rowing Club is hiring a full-time club head coach. The head coach will oversee all rowing programs at the club and contribute to an environment that nurtures club excellence and the development of great people through the sport of rowing. The head coach will focus on club level programs and will work with paid and volunteer coaches and the club manager to establish and deliver club programs for all ability levels. The club coach will be the lead coach for the master's program. The head coach work with the board through the Vice-President Programs. The club coach will promote a healthy, supportive and respectful boathouse culture focused on excellence in sport.

**About Us:** The RRC is 116 years old and trains in the heart of Regina on Wascana Lake. The lake is a 3km loop with a fully buoyed 1,000m course that annually hosts the Western Canada Sprints regatta and has hosted Canada Games in 2005, the NWIRA, and Canadian Masters Nationals. We have a full fleet of sculling and sweep boats, 2 wakeless launches for coaching and an indoor training center with changes rooms and showers. The RRC receives exceptional support from SaskSport and the Saskatchewan Rowing Association.

**Candidate:** You are passionate about the sport of rowing. You are engaging, fun, responsible and motivated. You have coaching experience as an assistant or head coach at the club or university level. You are organized and have strong communication skills.

**Employment:** The club's preference is to hire a full-time year around coach, however, we are open to candidates who are only interested or able to coach this summer, from the start of May to the end of August. The start date is flexible, but the successful candidate will ideally be in Regina for May 1, but may start work remotely prior to that. Candidates returning to school in the fall may depart mid-August.

**Flexible Hours:** The workload during the summer will be 40 hours per week. During the week, you will typically coach two rowing sessions per day (no more than 2), typically 1 in the morning and 1 in late afternoon or evening. There is one session Saturday morning. You will attend all club and provincial regattas unless otherwise negotiated.

**Remuneration:** Salary to be negotiated based on coaching experience and certification.
