Roles and Responsibilities - Please note modifications may arise due to covid-19 restrictions.

The Saskatchewan Rowing Association (SRA) is seeking one qualified Summer Development Coach who shall be responsible for coaching Summer Camp participants in the basics of rowing alongside the summer staff team of the Saskatoon Rowing Club. In addition, the Summer Development coach will travel to Lloydminster and Prince Albert and nearby provincial/regional parks to offer Just Try It Days and weekend Learn to Rows. The Coach provides an enjoyable experience that will encourage participants to become further involved with Rowing in Saskatchewan. The goal of a Summer Development Coach is to create a fun atmosphere for participants through confident instruction, enthusiasm and safety. His/her interaction with summer program participants and/or parents will be central to the impressions of the SRA and the sport of rowing formed by newcomers. Additionally, the Coach is a role model for new comers, as well as experienced athletes, and his/her ability to handle stressful situations in a mature manner along with strong conflict resolution skills are paramount in ensuring that everyone at the events has a fun and successful summer. The Coach reports to the Director of Operations and Head Technical Sport Developer.

Rowing Development & Coaching - Club

- Coach/instruct Learn to Row training sessions/camps at the Saskatoon/Lloydminster & Prince Albert Rowing Clubs
- Assist with and instruct high-school, adult Prairie Central Learn to Rows
- Assist with welcoming new members to the Club. Help new members find their way around the club
- Assist Club Manager with coordination of Club-wide events
- Assist with regatta preparations (packing for trailer loading, etc.)
- Assist with day-to-day management of boathouse activities (membership demands, program demands, keeping boathouse tidy, etc.)
- Assist with Boat repairs and club clean-up as required
- Other duties as assigned
- Work closely with clubs to ensure that all Covid-19 prevention protocols are implemented.

Rowing Development & Coaching - Sport Districts

- Coach/instruct training sessions/camps for rowing in Sport Districts that do not currently have rowing.
- Travel with a trailer and boats will be required. There will be a minimum of four trips over the course of the 10 weeks.

Adaptive Rowing

- Support adaptive rowing opportunities within the Saskatoon Rowing Club including either dryland or on-water components.

Training

- Staff will receive training at the beginning of the work term regarding:
 - a. Safe operation of safety boats
 - b. Safety procedures at host club
 - c. Safe handling of materials used for boat repair (PPE provided)
 - d. Rigging training

- LTR Trained with completion of MED, Rowing Essentials & Coaching Initiation in Sport
- Knowledge of the sport of rowing
- Ability to coach sweep and scull rowing
- Coaching experience preferred
- CPR-C and AED certification preferred
- Pleasure Craft License
- Successful completion of a Sterling Backcheck Criminal Background Check with Vulnerable Sector Search
- Must be willing to work some evenings and weekends to accommodate rowing schedule
- Must be willing to travel outside of Saskatoon to support rowing development
